

## MAINTENANCE MANUAL FOR CRITERION STEEL FOLDING GATES

- Occasionally brush or vacuum bottom tracks to keep them free of dust and dirt that might eventually interfere with ease of gate operation.
- 2. Use oil sparingly to prevent runs. We recommend WD-40 or other light spray lubricant. Lube all of the moving parts at friction points such as rivets, hinges, clips, shears, and catches. Also lightly spray rollers. Always hold cardboard or absorbent material behind sprayed area to prevent damage to walls, drapes, etc. from overspray.
- 3. Wipe off excess oil and clean inside bottom tracks to prevent build-up.
- 4. Interior mounted gates should have this service approximately twice a year. Exterior mounted gates require service more often depending on location and proximity to water, dirt and the elements.
- 5. Visually inspect entire gate when doing this service for signs of loose track, brackets, or other hardware that could adversely affect operation.
- 6. If bent or damaged components are present, contact **Criterion Products** or an authorized distributor for additional service or repair as required.
